In presenting this Seventeenth Cerne Abbas Music Festival we are proud, once again, to welcome the Gaudier Ensemble and guests to present their most ambitious series of concerts yet.

We are delighted that the wonderful soprano Patricia Rozario will be joining them for many of the concerts and that we can hear, for the first time, the beautiful late-romantic songs of Mahler and Berg.

The Saturday concerts will be a particular treat focussing entirely on music from Vienna. The enchanting works of Schubert will feature alongside early romantic works by Berg, Webern and Schoenberg which will surprise listeners with their luscious harmonies and beautiful sonorities.

Schoenberg's Verklärte Nacht (Transfigured Night) was inspired by a poem about a man and a woman walking through a forest on a moonlit night. A perfect way to end our late-night concert.

Other highlights include Mendelssohn's youthful Octet, a Mozart Piano Concerto with Susan Tomes and a Baroque evening, culminating with one of Bach's most beautiful Cantatas. These works alongside lesser known pieces by Spohr, Hummel and others should provide us with a feast of music-making.

We do hope you will join us.

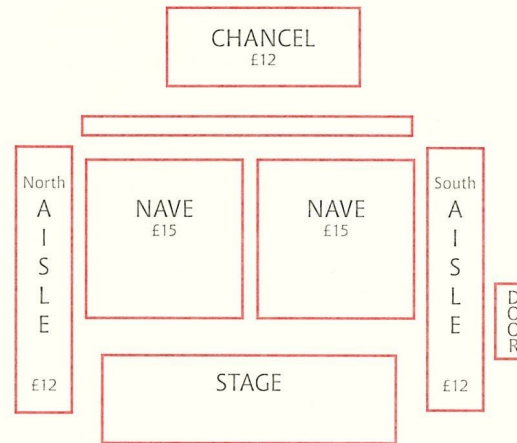
HOW TO BOOK

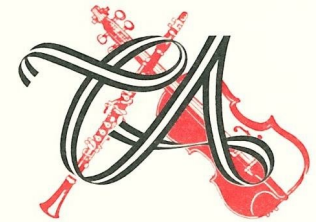
